

2017 Homecoming Dress Up Days

Tuesday, September 5- Pajama Day

Students may wear their PJ's. Please make sure they are appropriate for school. If you do not participate, you must wear your school uniform. You are NOT allowed to wear miniskirts, shorts, or leggings.

Wednesday, September 6- Neon Day

Students may wear BRIGHT colors!! Please make sure they are appropriate for school. If you do not participate, you must wear your school uniform. You are NOT allowed to wear miniskirts, shorts, or leggings.

Thursday, September 7- Color War Day

Students may wear anything that falls within the previously mentioned guidelines that is a part of their color costume. Any other clothing or shoes must be uniform.

Pre K3-- Your color is **BLUE!!!!**

Pre K4 and 7th-- Your color is **GREEN!!!!**

K, 2nd, and 8th-- Your color is **ORANGE!!!!**

1st, 3rd and 9th-- Your color is **RED!!!!**

4th and 10th-- Your color is **WHITE!!!!**

5th and 11th-- Your color is **BLUE!!!!**

6th and 12th-- Your color is **BLACK!!!!**

Friday, September 8- Purple & Gold Day

Students may wear anything purple and/or gold. Please make sure they are appropriate for school. If you do not participate, you must wear your school uniform. This is a great day to wear your 2017 Homecoming t-shirt with khaki pants or shorts!!

Please review the following guidelines for the homecoming dress up days.

Homecoming Dress Up Day Guidelines

1. Students can wear hats as part of their dress up Tuesday-Friday. Students must remove hats in the classroom if the teacher requests or if the hats become too distracting.
2. Students must wear pants that are a part of their costume. For example, if jeans are a part of the costume for color war on Thursday or spirit day on Friday, they will be allowed. **Jeans must follow the handbook guidelines as far as being hemmed and containing NO holes or rips.** Students must wear khaki uniform bottoms when jeans are not a part of their costumes. **Leggings DO NOT count as pants.**
3. Skirts that are a part of an outfit MUST be knee length. These cannot be made of see through material.
4. Shorts that are part of an outfit MUST follow the uniform guidelines. **No Nike shorts are allowed.** Blue jean shorts must be the students particular color on Thursday. Students should wear uniform shorts or pants if they are in doubt. Blue jean shorts must be uniform length.
5. Students must wear shirts with sleeves for all dress up days. Shirts may not have revealing necklines or offensive/suggestive sayings. Shirts cannot be see through. Students must wear shirts that show their color on color war day and that are purple/gold on Friday. Students can wear their Homecoming t-shirt on Friday. If in doubt, students should wear a uniform shirt.
6. Students may wear shoes Tuesday-Friday that match their outfit. Students must wear shoes that follow the uniform guidelines if they decide not to participate.
